

[Executive Director's note:

There weren't actual minutes taken for the January 2023 meeting, as the only substantive part of the meeting was the announcement of BOD election results, followed by a tour of the newly-upgraded production studio, and a fond farewell to and from departing Board President Andris Zobs. In light of that, and in lieu of minutes, text of an email sent from the Executive Director to all BOD candidates, announcing the election results, is below:]

After a long process of weeding out votes from non-members, the results are in. This is by far the most participation we've had in a Board election, with 93 participants (84 of whom were eligible members). The largest voter turnout in my memory was 40 people, two years ago. This election was way more competitive and drew more engagement than that one, by more than double.

Board Members starting their 3-year terms tonight are (in descending vote total order): Laura Silva, Chris Coady, Dave Colucci, Dan Bostick, Mike Loperfido, and TJ McIntyre. As I've said before, I wish we had 9 open seats, because there wasn't anyone on the ballot that I wasn't excited to see on the Board. For those who didn't get enough votes this time, I will keep you at the top of the list for appointments, should any seat become vacant.

The Annual Meeting is tonight, technically a Board Meeting but, given the large turnover, without much substantive agenda. We will review the last year at KBUT, toast departing members, briefly honor outgoing President Andris Zobs, announce these results, and schedule the March meeting. I hope to see you all at 5:30 at the KBUT studios (in the middle room) but, if you were elected, you need not be present to be added to the Board. Soft and non-soft drinks will be served.
