

## A letter from our Executive Director

#### Dear Listeners,

A statisticant, and community involvement. What an eventful, successful year here at KBUT. We realized a years-long goal to fully upgrade our studios, set our sights on a new Strategic Plan, and held two record-setting pledge drives in a row. I'm proud to be a part of it all, and thankful for the community support that makes it happen, including yours.

**New Studio** Our Audioarts A50 Console was installed in the main studio in August 1999. It ran continuously, with less than 48 hours of being powered down, for almost 24 years. The IRS depreciation schedule lists its useful life as 10 years. Like everyone here at KBUT, this equipment went above and beyond what was expected. The console played music from hundreds of KBUT DJs in its time and brought world news to the Gunnison Valley for decades. The years took their toll, and we've been working toward upgrading the console for as long as I've been working here and way before I started. On July 14, 2023, at 2pm, Lonesome Bob signed on in a completely upgraded studio as Staff, Board Members, luminaries from KBUT's long history, and the public watched. He came through loud and clear, and we cut the ribbon on our new studios, a culmination of years of planning and months of work by our staff, patience from our volunteers, and expertise from our installers. **Strategic Plan** KBUT's administration sat down in June, after extensive interviews with Staff, Board Members, former Board Members and other stakeholders, to discuss a vision for the future of KBUT. At the September board meeting, we adopted KBUT's new Strategic Plan. The strategic priorities we identified are as follows: intentional program development and growth; strong fiscal planning and management; building an infrastructure to support KBUT's mission; deliberate unification of the Gunnison Valley; and enhancing and expanding community awareness of KBUT. The process enhanced our collective understanding of, and appreciation for, this amazing organization we get to be a part of. The plan itself gives a detailed roadmap towards those goals, which everyone at KBUT is excited to implement. One exciting project in the coming year is relocating a translator to better serve CB South, Skyland, and other communities along the north end of Highway 135 with a clear radio signal to show off the amazing sound quality from our new studio.

## News and Programming

KBUT is deeply connected to the Gunnison Valley community - we know the people, the issues and the history. KBUT broadcasts 24 hours a day, seven days a week and is the most reliable source for timely information about local news, weather, arts and culture, political issues, recreation, the environment and emergency information.

#### From the News Desk

KBUT Community Radio is the only daily news produced in the Gunnison Valley. When the Lowline Fire was reported earlier this summer, KBUT produced daily updates on fire activity, road and trail closures and information regarding public lands.

- >> The KBUT News Department produces daily newscasts including the noon newscast, River Report, and newscasts within All Things Considered.
- >> The News Department covers local elections including this year's Gunnison Watershed School District board elections.

  KBUT broadcasts live forums and candidate debates in partnership with the Gunnison League of Women Voters,

  The Gunnison Country Times, and the Crested Butte News.

#### Snow, Trails + Water

- In partnership with Crested Butte Mountain Resort, Monarch Mountain, CB Nordic, Gunnison Nordic, and Gunnison Trails, KBUT provides a daily Ski and Snow Report.
- The Avalanche Report airs daily during ski season in partnership with the Crested Butte Avalanche Center. We provide critical information for backcountry ski, snowshoe, and snowmobile users.
- >> The River Report is aired daily from April to September and informs local river users about changing flows in local rivers.
- We regularly host leaders of Crested Butte Mountain Bike Association, Gunnison Trails, and High Country Conservation Advocates to discuss trail status, etiquette, and issues affecting trail all trail users.
- >> Headwaters, produced by Stephanie Maltarich, KBUT's 5-part series addressing issues about being a headwater community at a pivotal time for water in the West, won a 1st place award with Top of the Rockies.

#### KBUT increased its local news coverage this year,

including coverage of wolf reintroduction, affordable housing updates, climate marches, grocery mergers, book bans, snowmelt studies, the post office problems, and more.

#### We increased arts and culture coverage,

including performances at local theaters including the Mallardi, the Center for the Arts, and the Majestic Theater.

#### **Rocky Mountain Community Radio**

- » Rocky Mountain Community Radio (RMCR) is a coalition of non-commercial radio stations in Colorado, New Mexico, Utah, and Wyoming. collaborates to produce news and enterprise journalism that connects our communities.
- » RMCR is committed to the coverage of issues and public policy and employs a reporter at the Colorado State Capitol. Capitol Coverage by reporter Lucas Brady Woods is broadcast across the Rocky Mountain Community Radio network.
- This past year was the beginning of working with Managing Editor Maeve Conran, who helps coordinate news collaboration and content distribution through our region. That includes weekly communication regarding collaborative story coverage and educational opportunities for radio journalists.



#### **New Soundboards**

We are very proud and excited to announce that our new soundboard installations were a huge success. Kelley Dole trained all our 50 plus DJs on how to operate the new equipment. Both our Production and On Air Studios are now outfitted with brand new, state of the art soundboard systems. The sound quality of our broadcast has significantly improved. Can you hear the difference?

## News and Programming



#### **KBUT's Commitment to Live Music + Performing Arts**

- >> We gave away more than 160+ tickets to shows at venues including the Almont Resort, Center for the Arts, I Bar Ranch, Mt. Crested Butte stages, Public House, and other regional festivals and venues.
- >> KBUT's Entertainment Calendar is an inclusive list of all the performing arts happening in the Valley. It airs three times daily and is available at GunnisonValleyCalendar.com.
- >> We hosted interviews and live performances with bands coming to town, including memorable performances from Grammy Award winning New Orleans based Cha Wa, the all-female band Big Richard, urban folk legend G-Love, and bluegrass royalty Sam Grisman Project.

#### Music + Local Current Affairs until 5pm

Listeners asked for it. KBUT responded! KBUT made the decision to provide listeners with music up until 5pm Tuesday through Friday. On Mondays from 4-5pm we rotate every other week with Community Matters, featuring interviews with local Gunnison Valley leaders and Rocky Mountain Community Radio Regional Round Up, a collection of current stories reported by our RMCR member stations across Colorado, Wyoming, Utah, New Mexico and Montana.

#### **KBUT Youth Programs**

The KBUTeens and KBUT Kid Radio Club are in their fourth year of youth programming. Both groups are collaborative projects with the Crested Butte Community School Enrichment Program. The KBUTeens Radio Show can be heard every Saturday at Noon and every other Monday at 4pm with RMCR Round Up. The KBUT Kid-produced radio promotions are aired throughout the week between morning and evening shows.

Lizzy Plotkin's Music School Lessons started its third year at KBUT. The Third Annual Children's Holiday Showcase featuring a live winter recital performance by Lizzy's fiddle and guitar students will air in late December during the holidays.

#### **Turnstyles Late Night**

Catch Turnstyles overnight programming from 11pm-4am every night. It's a genre-defying eclectic music show with a unique freeform music mix produced by radio veteran DJs based in Boulder. They spin a handmade mixtape of underheard and overlooked recordings just for you!

This past July 4<sup>th</sup> parade we had the best turn out ever with an all-ages crew of disco divas shakin' it all the way up Elk Avenue.


#### **KBUT Kampout**


