


KBUT ANNUAL REPORT 2024





A LETTER FROM OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

2024 HAS BEEN YET ANOTHER STELLAR YEAR AT KBUT.

Two more historically successful Pledge Drives have hammered home the fact that this community loves us. And we love our community back. At our DJs' urging, we've endeavored this year to be present in person in our community even more than before. We've expanded our engagement efforts in Gunnison, including tabling multiple I Bar Ranch Summer Concerts and DJing at GVH's Annual Pumpkin Patch and Western Colorado University's Homecoming. We also DJed the Alley Loop and Grand Tasting for the Center for the Arts Wine and Food Festival in Crested Butte. Some of these are annual KBUT appearances, but we've added more this year, especially at the south end of the Valley. We also doubled down on our involvement with the Spanish-speaking community in the Gunnison Valley, translating our PSAs and adding our first Spanish-language program, Ritmos Del Mundo with Yamel, Sundays from 3-5pm.

We bid a fond farewell to Kelley Dole in July, and News Director Kate Gienapp stepped into the Program Director role, managing all our 80+ volunteer DJs while not missing a beat as we continue to grow our News Department. Courtney and Tyler in our Development Department continue to excel at raising money for, and awareness of, KBUT's mission, and financially we're in our strongest position ever. Our events continue to draw huge crowds, with March's Disco Inferno bringing in an unprecedented amount of community financial support (and fun).

We added 13 new fully trained DJs to our family of volunteers, 3 of whom already have full time shows on the schedule. It's amazing to watch the DJ email list and see how quickly and enthusiastically our DJs step in to fill each others' shows. I don't think about it as much as I should but, when I actually do the math, every week of KBUT programming contains 86 hours of volunteer-produced content, representing at least 106 hours of volunteer time per week. That's at least 5,512 hours of local volunteerism every year, just on the air, and that doesn't include the hundreds of hours of volunteering at our events and appearances. Our product is great radio, but the byproduct of how we get it done is well over 500 hours per month of volunteering for KBUT from people all across our listening area and beyond. Between that and the community financial support we get from our Underwriters and at every Pledge Drive and fundraiser, there's no denying that KBUT and the Gunnison Valley community are inextricably bound together, and it all comes from a love of radio and this place we live.

I'm running out of ways to say how proud I am of this organization, but for all the reasons above, and many more, it's an honor. The outpouring of community support and volunteerism is incredibly validating for our small paid staff, and it's what keeps us coming to work. If you're reading this, you're a part of it, so thank you.

FREELANCE REPORTER WORK and other opportunities for DJs:

Freelance reporter Chad Reich produces a bi-weekly feature called "Word on the Street" where he asks the community a single question about the latest local happenings. Reich has covered impacts to local businesses following the closure of the Middle Bridge over Highway 50 earlier this summer, changes the Town of Crested Butte's parking, how the Town's Transportation Plan has impacted travel throughout Town with new parklets and flower boxes.

DJs now have opportunities to train on all things radio and news related including how to conduct live interviews, use a recorder and gather sound.

JOURNALISM & DEMOCRACY IN THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA — a community conversation

On May 23rd the *Colorado Sun's* Sandra Fish, *Gunnison Country Times'* Bella Biondini and Alan Wartes, *Crested Butte News'* Mark Reaman, and KBUT Community Radio's Kate Gienapp joined in a panel discussion on the critical connection between journalism and democracy. Western Colorado University's (and KBUT DJ) Toni Todd hosted the panel in a discussion highlighting each panelist's approach to covering the news and candidates in an election year.

COLLABORATIVE REPORTING

KBUT partnered with KFNF Community Radio in Paonia and Rocky Mountain Community Radio (RMCR) for combined coverage of the Middle Bridge Closure on Highway 50. This included coverage of local meetings here in Gunnison County, stories on how students get to and from school, business impacts and stories about our agricultural community.

SEASONAL REPORTS

This spring was the start of a completely new River Report. The report includes a variety of river-related information, including upcoming swiftwater rescue classes, river festival information, and other information that is pertinent to a wide variety of river users in the Gunnison Valley.

LIVE CALL-IN SHOWS

KBUT aired two live call-in shows in coordination with RMCR and the Above the Noise project. The topic was the urban/rural divide and how it plays out around issues like the mountain lion hunting ballot measure. We had great participation locally with three callers from Gunnison County who were listening and asking really great questions. We also aired a call-in show under the same format for the ballot measure on Rank choice voting.

2024 ELECTION COVERAGE

KBUT provided election coverage in coordination with RMCR to share community voices about what's on people's minds and what impacts them most with election issues. We provided the first ever KBUT 2024 Election Guide and day-of Election Results posted to our website.

KBUT partnered with our local newspapers, the *Gunnison Country Times* and the *Crested Butte News* to air/livestream local debates for Gunnison County Commissioners.



ROCKY MOUNTAIN COMMUNITY RADIO

Rocky Mountain Community Radio (RMCR) is a coalition

of non-commercial radio stations in Colorado, New Mexico, Utah, and Wyoming. collaborates to produce news and enterprise journalism that connects our communities.

RMCR is committed to the coverage of issues and public policy and employs a reporter at the Colorado State Capitol. Capitol Coverage by reporter Lucas Brady Woods is broadcast across the Rocky Mountain Community Radio network.

KBUT YOUTH PROGRAMS:

The KBUTeens and KBUT Kid Radio Club are in their fourth year of youth programming. Both groups are collaborative projects with the Crested Butte Community School Enrichment Program. The KBUTeens Radio Show can be heard every Saturday at Noon and every other Monday at 4:00 PM. The KBUT Kid-produced radio promotions are aired throughout the week between morning and evening shows.



CRESTED BUTTE JULY 4 TH PARADE


This past 4th of July parade we had the best turnout ever with an all-ages crew of disco divas shakin' it all the way up Elk Avenue.
